Classes by Kathy Hinckley

Knitting Lace (3 hours) Cost \$40.00, 11/1 10a-1p, 11/9 2p-5p, 11/14 10a,1p, 11/21 10a-1p

You can knit lace! Learn how lace patterns are built, how to read charted lace directions and follow patterns with repeats, and how to choose yarns that show off your work best.

Students will work two lace-patterned swatches and two edgings.

Bring 50-100g fingering or sport weight smooth yarn, light color, and needles in several sizes beginning about 4 sizes larger than suggested on the label (i.e., for fingering, bring 7, 8, maybe 9 or even 10 if you knit tightly; for sport weight, bring 9, 10, 10.5, 11)

Knitting from Charts (3 hours) Cost \$40.00, 11/3 2p-5p, 11/4 10a-1p, 11/16 2p-5p, 11/22 10a-1p

Knitting from charted patterns is easy! Learn how charts actually simplify directions for knit-purl stitch patterns, cables, other texture patterns, color motifs and lace patterns, and how to chart patterns yourself.

Students will knit swatches from at least two different charts in class; those who knit fast can do more. We will also chart a stitch pattern from written-out directions.

Bring 50-100g any smooth yarn (the thicker the yarn, the more you should bring), easy-to-see color; appropriately sized needles, plus some much larger needles (four or more sizes larger) for lace example; cable needle; pencil with eraser, a few sheets of blank paper or a notebook. If you are comfortable working with two colors at a time, bring a contrasting color of the same weight yarn. Colored markers or pencils if desired. Graph paper will be provided.

Finishing (3 hours) Cost \$40.00, 11/1 2p-5p, 11/7 6p-9p, 11/9 10a-1p, 11/12 2p-4p, 11/14 2p-5p, 11/18 10a-1p, 11/30 2p-5p

Learn the professional way to sew seams, weave in ends and add those finishing touches. Bring your own garment pieces for seaming and finishing, or get a free pattern at sign-up for a baby sweater to knit BEFORE CLASS (you can donate it to Stitches from the Heart afterward, if you like).

Along with your garment ready for finishing and some extra garment yarn, also bring two small identical square swatches (any yarn) and a little extra yarn, crochet hook, tapestry needle, ruler, dpns in main size and (if applicable) ribbing size, extra yarn for seams and finishing details, notions and other tools called for in your pattern.

**Premie Baby Sweater – designed by Kathy Hinckley. This isn't the usual baby sweater. It's designed for teaching finishing techniques, so it has structure and details usually omitted in baby sweaters, but common in adult ones: set-in sleeves, picked-up button plackets and button holes, shaped collar. Once it's finished and the techniques learned, if you don't know a very small baby who can use the sweater, you can donate it to Stitches from the Heart.

Fix Knitting Mistakes (2 hours) Cost \$25.00, 11/10 11a-1p, 11/12 10a-12n, 11/18 2p-4p, 11/29, 1p-3p

Help is here! You can learn to rescue your own knitting boo-boos without going crazy. Fix dropped stitches, wrongly crossed cables, even mistakes in lace and color patterns, without ripping out hours and hours of work!

Bring at least two swatches, about 25 sts x 20 rows, on the needles, and some extra yarn, as follows:

One Stockinette stitch swatch

At least one of the following: a garter stitch swatch,
 a lace-pattern swatch,
 a cable swatch,
 a two-color pattern swatch

We will be working on all the above, so the more of them you bring, the more you can participate. (One 50g ball of smooth, light-colored yarn should be enough for all swatches, except for optional two-color swatch.) Also bring: two dpns; a few safety pins or locking stitch markers; tapestry needle. Optional: A small throw pillow and a few t-pins or flower-head pins.

Cables (2 hours) Cost \$25.00, 11/2 11a-1p, 11/10 2p-4p, 11/15, 11a-1p, 11/28, 11a-1p

Cables and texture add interest to your knitting. Learn the one, simple operation needed to cable stitch, the many effects that can be achieved by cabling, and how cables effect other aspects of a design.

Students will knit two swatches: a swatch with two mirror-imaged pairs of different cables (2 x 2 over 4 rows and 4 x 4 over 8 rows); a swatch with a diamond on purl ground, seed st center *or* a shadow cable.

Bring 50g, of smooth, medium to light colored yarn, worsted or thinker, and appropriately sized needles. Cable needles of different types will be provided so you can try them out to see what you prefer.

OTHER CLASSES: Every Monday except the first Monday of the month – Needlepoint classes with Donna from 6p-8p and every Friday from 1p-3p the cost is \$90.00 for (6) lessons.

Knitting or Crochet classes every Monday from 6p-8p with Leah, \$25.00 for (2) hours.

The fourth Saturday of every month, Monthly Afghan Squares from 10:30a-12:30p. Each square will teach you different stitches and techniques. Learn beading, bobbles, cables, etc., \$37.50 plus materials.

** Please note no refunds on classes and must be paid prior to the schedules date. Classes can be paid either in person or over the telephone. If you do not have the yarn for the class please stop by the shop and choose your yarns so that we can wind them for you.
